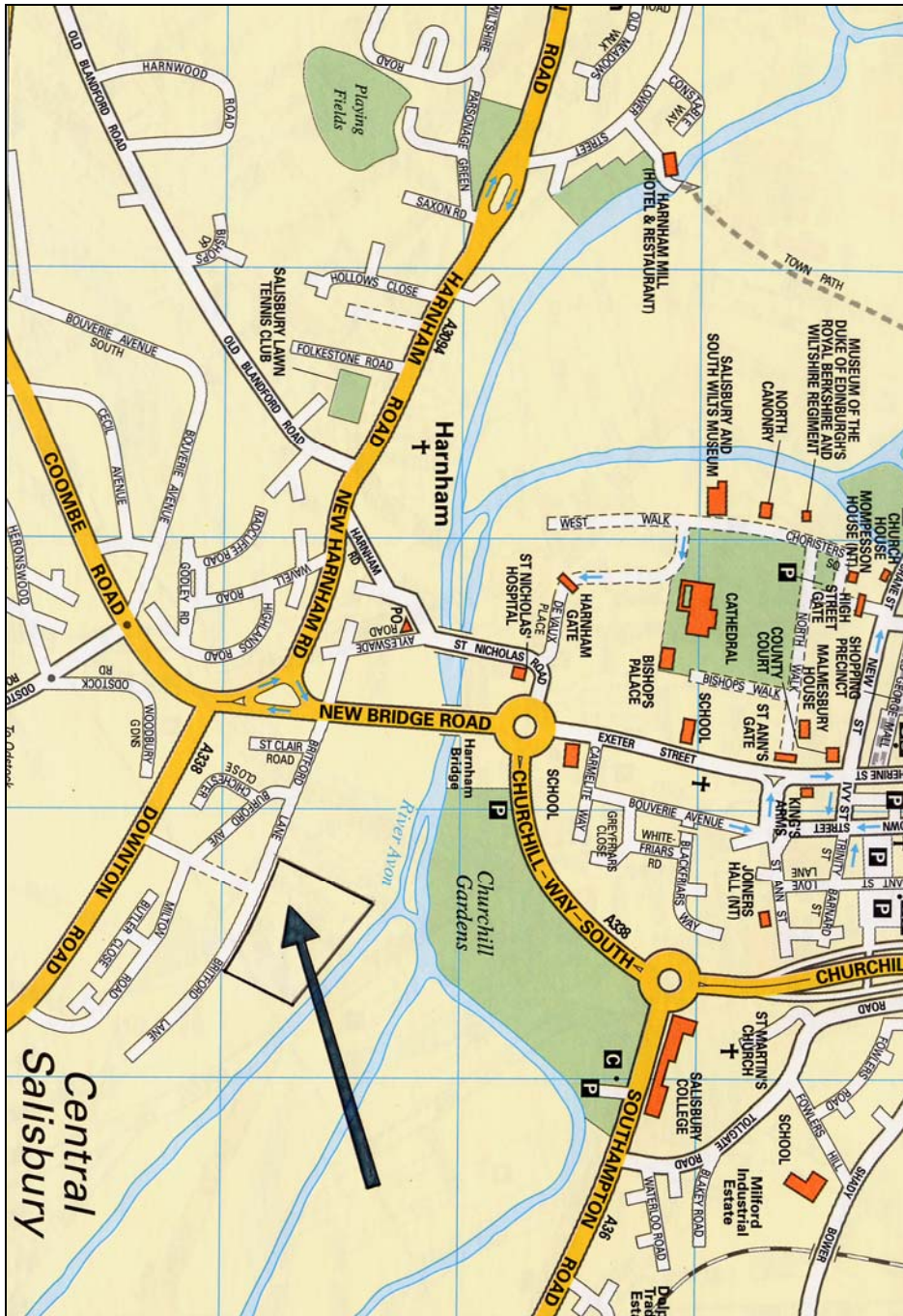

Only members of G.N.A.S. or F.I.T.A. are permitted to shoot at this tournament.

RULES OF SHOOTING

The shoot will be conducted under G.N.A.S. Rules of Shooting.
Dress Regulation rule 307 will apply.
Bouncers will not be claimed and there will be no visual time control.

UK RECORD STATUS

This shoot will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Written parental consent must be provided for juniors.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Anyone wishing to take photographs of the event must register with the Tournament Organiser.

Number of competing archers per group and awards provided at this shoot

- 1 to 3 archers – Gold only
- 4 to 6 archers – Gold & Silver
- 7 archers or more – Gold, Silver & Bronze

RECURVE TEAM of 4 archers must include 1 lady or gent, and 3 must be seniors.

MIXED TEAM of 4 (2 recurve & 2 compound) must include 1 lady or gent, and 3 must be seniors.

SHORT METRIC OPEN MEDALS awarded to 3rd class archers and below
